Free Deck Case & Stencil Download Version 1.0

Hello, and thank you for visiting our website! We hope you enjoy the case designs so much that you'll come back and try out our deck box templates as well. If not, no worries—we hope you enjoy this download.

Getting Started

Step 1: Read the **DeckCaseStencilInstructions** document or watch the tutorial on YouTube to learn how to create any of the four deck case stencils.

Step 2: Gather the supplies needed for the process. If you'd like more guidance, check out our **ItemsToPurchase** video on YouTube.

Step 3: Create your first deck case stencil.

Step 4: Read the **DeckCaseBuilder** manual or watch the video on building a deck case. We recommend watching the full video before starting, so you understand why each step matters.

Tip: Use packaging you don't mind messing up for your first attempt. You might get it right the first time, but it often takes a couple of tries to perfect the process.

Final Notes: There are four stencils included. Two are labeled "24pop" and two are "24beer." Additionally, two are marked "NSSS" and two are "DS."

- NSSS stands for Non-Sleeved or Single-Sleeved decks.
- DS stands for Double-Sleeved decks only.
- Our double-sleeved deck boxes are 4 mm wider than the NSSS boxes—and so are the cases. Choose your stencil based on the type of deck you want to house.
- 24pop stencils work with 24-can cases of pop, but not beer.
- 24beer stencils work with 24-can cases of beer, but not pop.

Each stencil includes a list of other compatible beverage packaging sizes. Currently, the smallest usable case is a 20-pack of pop. We haven't tested any 18-packs yet.

If you find any of our instructions confusing or if you find any errors in the downloads or in any of our videos, please let us know so that we can correct them. We appreciate it.
